


## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

The easiest way to mount the T-Slot Click-in-Nuts, is to slide them in from one side of the profile, with the ball facing down. But don't worry if you need to put in a click-in-nut in a profile which has both ends already closed: it is also possible to push them in the T-slot anywhere you like!


Screw the M4 spacers into the back of your monitor. Using a tool is not neccessary. Turning them by hand is fine, because you will tighten them on the next page when applying a screw driver.


Mount the VESA Bracket to the back of your monitor, using a screw driver.
